# Chaparral Suzuki Academy

- Violin students will be given a play-in list.
- Be prepared to play your polished (recital-ready) piece for your lesson class teacher and for the student recital.

## Concerts:

- All students will perform in the Celebration Concert on Saturday.
- Official attire for this concert will be blue jeans and the Academy T-Shirt that we will provide.
- Violinists & Violists will have an informal student recital during the institute.

## Practicing:

- Piano students will have assigned practice rooms and practice times for 30 minute time increments.
- Violinists do not have assigned practice times and locations. They may practice anywhere else on the premises during the hour long lunch period, or after Academy hours at another location.

**When & Where:** The Academy will run from Wednesday, June 14 through Saturday, June 17, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. The Academy will take place at St Luke's Episcopal Church, 2000 Shepherds Ln, Prescott, Arizona. There are many area attractions including Downtown Prescott with shops and restaurants, two lakes, hiking trails, a zoo, and a dog park. Participants are responsible to make their own arrangements for accommodations. A parent or responsible adult must attend and be present during academy hours.

**Lunch:** We will provide a one hour time to eat your lunch, but you must bring your own lunch, or make arrangements to eat at a local restaurant. No food or drinks are allowed in the church sanctuary or classrooms.

## Fees & Registration:

- The Suzuki Academy fee is \$325 for the complete session.
